A.G.E.H.R-AREA 2 will begin accepting applications for the **Hand Chime Lending Program** beginning March 1, 2012.



Applications will be accepted until all sets have been allocated for Summer 2012 and the school year 2012—2013.

Handchime Lending Program

The purpose of AGEHR Area 2's Handchime Lending Program is to promote the ringing of handchimes in Public or Private Elementary or Secondary Schools, Churches, or Community Groups within our area of Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey and Ontario. This program is a valuable introduction to the art of ringing instruments and often becomes a focal point in expanding such programs in the local community.

About the Loan Program

AGEHR Area 2 has several sets of three-octave handchimes to loan.

The loan period is:

One (1) school year (September 1 through June 1) with return of handchimes to Area 2 by June 15.

-OR-

One (1) summer session (July 1 – August 15) with return of handchimes to Area 2 by August 22.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Public or Private Elementary or Secondary school, Church, or Community Group within area 2 of AGEHR.
- 2. Handchimes will be loaned only once to a particular school, church or group.
- 3. Preference will be given to a new school district before another school within the same district.
- 4. Preference will be given to organizations with existing music programs.
- 5. Must be a member of AGEHR, or willing to become a member of AGEHR if loan is approved.

- 2-3 octaves, AGEHR level 2 or 2+
- Optional handchimes or other instruments may be used
- Intended playing time: Not to exceed 3 minutes
- An original handbell composition suitable for Young Ringers' An original handbell composition suitable for massed ringing
 - 3-5 octaves. AGEHR level 3
 - Optional handchimes or other instruments may be used
 - Intended Playing time: Not to exceed 4.5 minutes

Deadline: May 1, 2012 Contest Rules

- 1. ONLY ORIGINAL, UNPUBLISHED WORKS MAY BE SUBMITTED. **Any composition using a pre-existing melody will not be considered.** Entries may not be published or under consideration by any other contest or publisher while being considered by Area 2. Failure to observe this rule will result in immediate forfeiture of any prizes awarded.
- 2. Please use AGEHR publication *Handbell Notation and Grading System* as a reference guide for all compositional notation.
- 3. Composers may enter as many manuscripts as they wish, but each one is to be sent under a separate cover.
- 4. To enter, choose either A or B from the following:
- A) MAIL TEN(10) copies of the original piece on 8.5" by 11" paper printed double sided, and hole punched. Include title, category, bells used chart, optional instruments, and duration. DO NOT INCLUDE THE COMPOSER'S NAME ON THESE COPIES. Include one (1) cover sheet containing title, intended playing time, composer's name, e-mail address, address, and evening telephone number. Notification of the receipt of each entry will only be sent via email.
 - B) Electronically send One (1) File containing the following, each tested for usability prior to submission:
 - i. One(1) pdf file of the original piece formatted for printing on 8.5" by 11" paper. Include title, category, bells used chart, optional instruments, and duration. DO NOT INCLUDE THE COMPOSER'S NAME OR ANY OTHER IDENTIFYING MARK(s) WITHIN THIS FILE. Include one (1) file containing title, intended playing time, composer's name, e-mail address, address, and evening telephone number. Notification of the receipt of each entry will only be sent via email.
 - Ii. Any type of Audio file of the composition (DO NOT INCLUDE ANY AUDIO CONTAINING COMPOSER'S NAME OR ANY OTHER IDENTIFYING AUDIO COMMENTS)
- 6. Decision of the judges is final. Area 2 reserves the right to select entries that, in its sole judgment, are suitable for its festivals' purpose. Area 2 reserves the right not to award a prize in either or both categories.
- 7. Winning entries will be performed at the 2013 Young Ringers' Festival and Festival Conferences.
- 8. Area 2 will request a suitable dedication line when the composition is published. Area 2 reserves the right to be the sole dedicatee.
- 9. Winning compositions may <u>not</u> be presented or played in any national, area or local festival or ringing conference prior to the 2013 Area 2 Young Ringers' Festival and Festival Conferences.
- 10. Area 2 adheres to copyright laws. Copyright obligations and adherence to copyright laws is expected of all composers.
- 11. ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY May 1, 2012.
