# From the Chair...

Greetings from your Area 2 Board,

To all of the Bell Choir Directors receiving this newsletter: Are you taking a choir to the Area 2 Festival at SUNY Oswego in June? If not, do you share the information about the Festival with your ringers? You may have a ringer or ringers who would like to go on their own. They can register under your membership number. For any choir from which 4 or less ringers register, the ringers can sign up to ring with one of the three orphan choirs. If they don't even know about the event then they don't have the opportunity to make a choice. Go onto our website at www.area2agehr.org and check out the registration information.

You will see a different logo for Area 2 on this newsletter. At the February 2013 Area 2 board meeting the board voted to adopt the National Logo for use on our documents. When National rebranded a little more than a year ago, they adopted a new logo and created Area logos from that design for our use if we chose to use it. The board just this month voted to adopt that logo. You will now see it on our documents and on our Web Site.

If all goes as planned, the feature concert at the 2013 Festival in June will be the Virginia Handbell Consort. As per their web page "the group is comprised of auditioned musicians performing on over five octaves of Schulmerich bells, five and a half octaves of Melody Chimes, three octaves of Petit and Fritsen bells, and other percussion instruments." The group has been ringing for 17 years. Several of their members will also serve as clinicians at the festival.

Hope to see many of you at the Area 2 Festival Conference in June.

That also will soon be available. But the 3 octave piece is the one that Division B of the Young Ringers will be using.

The Festival Conference Contest winner is *With a Joyful Spirit*, Code AG35319, by Paul McKlveen.

I mistakenly posted the availability dates as January 15<sup>th</sup>. I am told that the expected date of release was actually February 15<sup>th</sup>. I apologize for any concerns in this matter.

# Classes and Clinicians for the 2013 Area 2 Festival at SUNY Oswego

These are not complete lists of clinicians and classes.

Clinicians so far engaged for the festival are:

Michael Joy, Ron Bellamy, Martha Alford, Janet Van Valey, Margi Zearley, Sue Garton, Jim Rossetti, John Baker, and Marilyn Shenenberger. In addition, ringers from the featured concert group will also be teaching.

Some of the classes planned are:

Tracks: Beginning and Intermediate Directors Tracks, Beginning Ensemble Track, and Beginning Solo Track.

Classes will include classes involving Movement and Dance, Musicality, Conducting, Solo and Ensemble ringing, Check -up on Techniques for Bronze Ringers (Are you as good as you think you are?), Bell Music Lingo, How to count those difficult rhythms, Battery Bells, and the usual bell techniques for Bass Ringers and Treble Ringers, Weaving, Rhythm, Stopped Sounds, etc.

We will offer a theory class. There will also be a class on Handchime techniques emphasizing what bell techniques are/are not transferable to chimes.

At this point of the Festival planning, if anyone out there has an idea for a class, please let me know. If there is a specific difficulty that your ringers have and it does not seem to be addressed here, let me know and I will see what I can do to include that in a class. Our clinicians are very talented and can teach just about anything you need to know.

There was a request to have a masseuse type person on hand to provide some relaxation for those aches and pains caused by ringing. The board has approved this, so we are looking for someone to provide that service. The person would charge a fee. We are unable to provide the service for free!

# Performance Track vs. Master Class

We plan to have two Performance Tracks rather than Master Classes at the upcoming festival.

We will be using the expertise of Bill Alexander, who directs a perfoming choir, to guide a group of participants in preparing a performance. This would include preparing the pieces by studying them in detail, as well as preparing the presentation – how does the group look as a whole, how does the group get on and off the stage, how does a choir acknowledge applause, etc. We plan to have two separate performance tracks - one for Bronze level ringers and one for Copper level ringers.

# **Membership Renewal Questions and Answers**

Is your membership due for annual renewal? There have been some questions about how membership is renewed and how someone is notified that it is time to renew.

When your membership is about to come up for renewal, you will be sent an e-mail 60 days prior to the due date, as a first reminder. If you don't renew your membership within a couple of weeks, a second reminder will be sent 30 days before the due date by snail mail. If we still have not received a renewal, a third reminder will be sent the day after the date of renewal with a follow-up e-mail 2 weeks later Please be sure all your contact information is up-to-date when you renew so that there is no error in trying to contact you. Your membership can be renewed by returning the form that comes by snail mail or at the national website at www.handbellmusicians.org.

Please know that your membership also helps to support Area 2! The area receives \$10 for every regular membership and \$5 for every student membership. These funds help to support area events, such as festivals and workshops.

# A TRACK FOR MUSIC EDUCATORS

# Handchime Lending Program:

The purpose of AGEHR Area 2's Handchime Lending Program is to promote the ringing of handchimes in Public or Private Elementary or Secondary schools, Churches, or Community Groups within our area of Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey and Ontario. This program is a valuable introduction to the art of ringing instruments and often becomes a focal point in expanding such programs in the local community.



#### **About the Loan Program**

AGEHR Area 2 has 9 sets of three-octave handchimes to loan.

### The loan periods are:

One (1) school year (September 1 through June) with return of handchimes to Area 2 by June 15, 2014.

-OR-

One (1) summer session (July 1 – August 15) with return of handchimes to Area 2 by August 22

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Public or Private Elementary or Secondary school, Church, or Community Group within Area 2 of AGEHR.
- 2. Handchimes will be loaned only once to a particular school, church or group.
- 3. Preference will be given to a new school district before another school within the same district.
- 4. Preference will be given to organizations with existing music programs.
- 5. Must be a member of AGEHR, or willing to become a member of AGEHR if loan is approved.


